

ONATHEM CONCENED CLOSERS

Single Acting, for Doors Hung on Butts

202 Nos. 204 206

The basic overhead concealed closer.

Mechanism installed in head frame and top of door. Power transmitted by a lever arm which disappears into recess in door stop upon closing. Used with exterior or interior doors of wood or metal 13/4" thick or more. Easily regulated without removing any part.


Door opening of 180° possible if door and jamb properly arranged. Hydrau-

lic back-check protects walls, furniture, etc. Door stop required if traffic tends to "ride" the door (see p. 3, sec. 9).

The hold-open feature (optional) may be set to hold at one of following door positions: 85°, 90°, 100° or 110°.

Phantom drawing shows LCN series 200 closer, designed for doors hung on butts. It is entirely independent of the door hanging. Door and/or frame may be wood or metal; if metal, preparation is done by fabricator.
