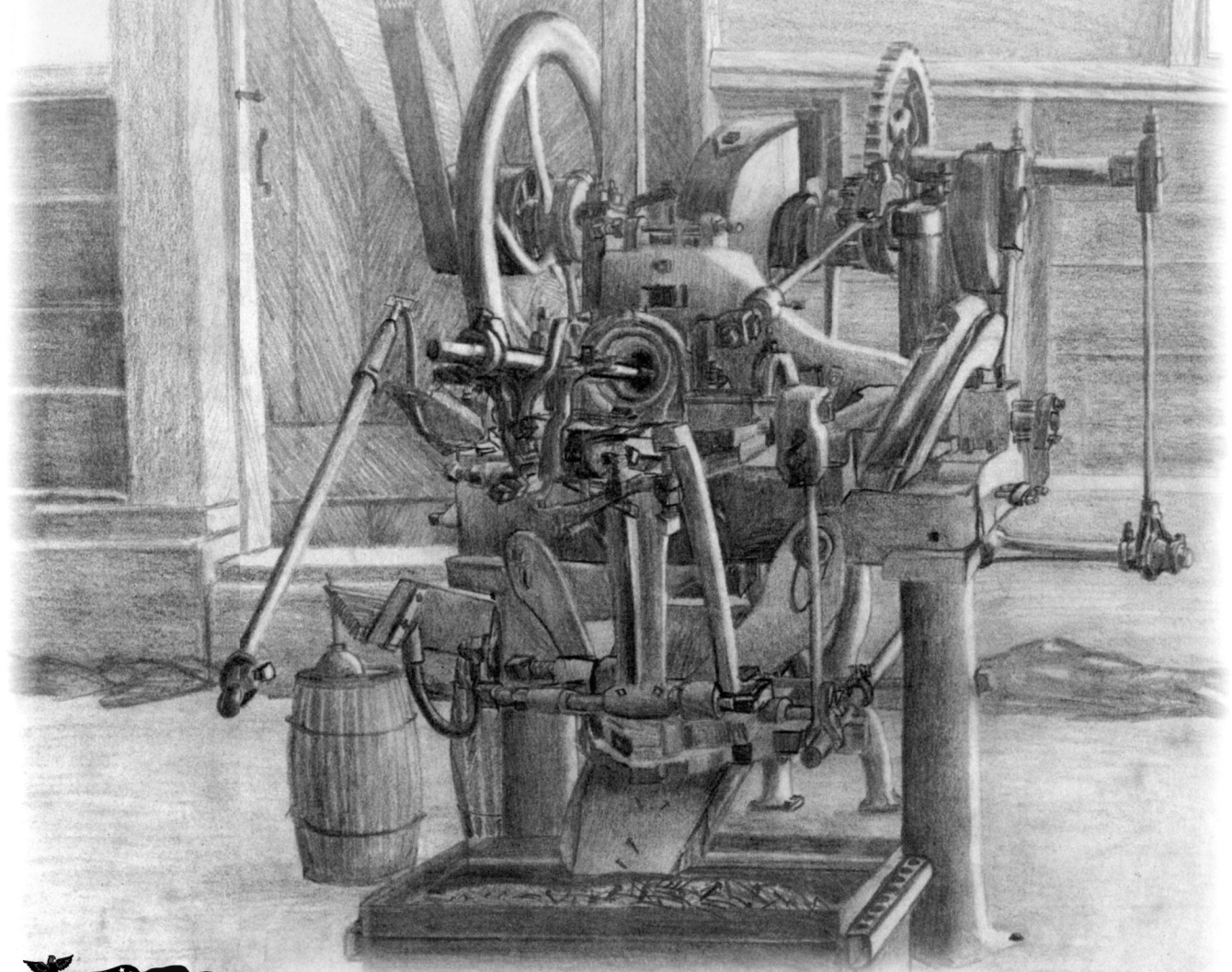

Returns & Exchanges

If you are not satisfied with a product, please contact our Customer Service Department. They will arrange to either have the merchandise picked up or provide you with a Return Materials Authorization (RMA) number.

For returns, your account will be credited less a 20% restock charge. Simply return the merchandise to us prepaid by either UPS or mail. The RMA number must be referenced on the returned merchandise.

For defective merchandise, we will gladly replace the product or credit towards a replacement product.

Non US Orders

DEFINITIONS

STANDARD – A steel cut nail with a powder-gray finish which can be clinched; not a hardened nail.

HARDENED – A nail which has been heat-treated and tempered for special hardness.

HOT-DIP GALVANIZED – A zinc-coated nail, hot dipped in molten zinc to resist rusting. These are not hardened nails. However, special order nails can be hardened and then hot-dipped. The additional price list to galvanize any nail not shown with a "Hot-Dip Galvanized" option is \$2.15 per pound, with a minimum order quantity of 250 pounds.

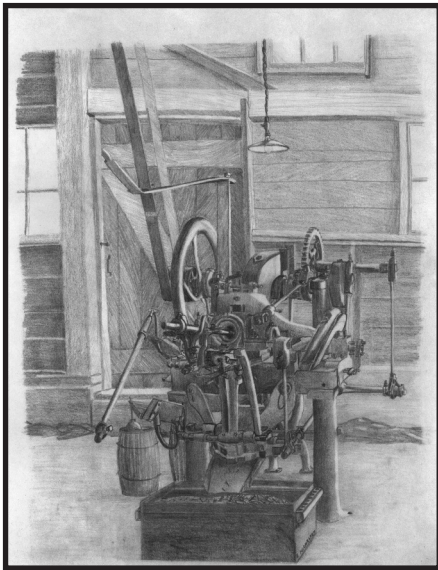
FACE NAILING – Nailing perpendicular to the board surface so that the head of the nail is exposed. Nailing in this manner can be for both functional and aesthetic purposes.

BLIND NAILING – Nailing at a 45-degree angle through the edge or butt-end of the board, which may be a flat surface, ship-lap or tongue-and-groove. Nails used in this fashion usually have small heads and are not visible when the installation is completed. Also called 'toe-nailing', the sole purpose of nailing in this manner is functional rather than aesthetic.

BLACK OXIDING – A black matte finish etched to the surface of the nail which is a standard offering on the Decorative Wrought Head nail and is available as an option on all other non-hardened patterns. The additional list price to place a black oxide finish on a nail is \$2.20 per pound, with a minimum order quantity of 100 pounds.

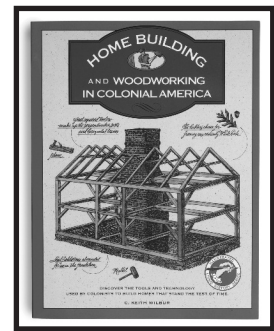


NAIL MACHINE PRINT

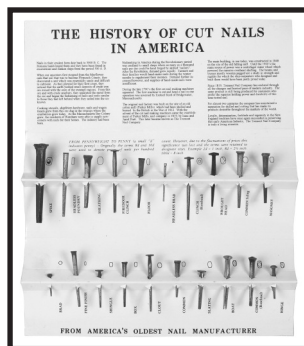

WOODEN NAIL KEGS

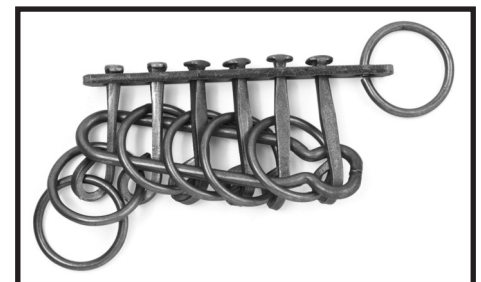

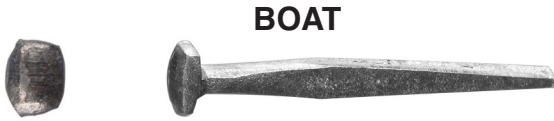
PATIENCE PUZZLE

Used for heavy construction work, these strong spikes drive well through planking and heavy timber for deck and bridge work. They are made on our oldest "nailer" (circa 1865) by heating the steel plate to a reddish hue and feeding it by hand into this massive machine. Spikes are cut at a rate of about 40 per minute.
