### THE "YALE" LOCKS.



THE above illustration represents the style of key which is used with all of the "Yale" Locks. It is made of cold-rolled sheet steel, highly polished and nickel-plated. The illustration represents the actual size of the key, the thickness of which is about 5-100 of an inch, thus rendering it the neatest and most convenient key ever made.

The introduction of flat keys, in connection with locks adapted to general purposes, originated with this Company some seventeen years ago, and in the United States this form of key (i. e., one made of sheet-metal), is fast superseding all others. 


