

Proposed Technical Tour on Friday the 21st September 2018

The following itinerary is suggested for the day between the one-day conference (20th) and the Entente Florale programme (22nd).

9.30 am – Meet at the former Town Council offices and walk to Lloyd Town Park where Mark Boyle of Murray & Associates (designers of the park) will provide a guided tour



11.00 – 11.30 am - Coffee Break – The venue will be decided on the day.

11.30 am – Travel by coach/car, depending on numbers to Charleville estate and view ancient oak trees with Aubrey Fennel, Author of Heritage Trees of Ireland, published by The Tree Council of Ireland



1.00 – 2.00pm - Lunch at a venue to be decided – Travel by coach/car.

2.00 pm Travel to Lough Boora Discovery Park– by car/coach depending on numbers. Lough Boora Discovery Park is in County Offaly and is open year-round. With access for all ages and abilities, this amenity can be explored for its outdoor activities, nature and biodiversity, sculptures and historical Mesolithic Site.



5.00 pm – Return to Tullamore.

Note:

There is no fee for access to any of the three sites, so the cost will essentially be for the hire of a bus, if needed. Smaller groups can be accommodated by cars. On the assumption that participants will provide/buy their own lunch, this trip will have a nominal fee of €15 per person, payable on the day.
