### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Your organization should be a not-for-profit society, a registered charity, or a government program.
- Your organization should be Alberta-based and deliver services within the province of Alberta.
- Your project should have a sustainability/energy-efficiency component.
- Your submission should be signed by two officers from your organization.
- Your submission must be submitted electronically, as a Word document, maximum 2 pages, size 10, Arial font.

#### Description of Your Organization

Please tell us about your organization, the people who work within it, and those who benefit from your services. Links and web addresses may be included for information.

#### Project Overview

Describe your dream project! Projects could include a new building, exterior or interior renovation, or energy-efficient upgrades.

#### Impact

Describe how a conceptual design or feasibility study would benefit your organization and its ability to grow, and provide services into the future.
