Dog Control, Safety, and Risk Notice

Definitions:

Dog Parent means any person (over 18 years old) owning, possessing, or controlling a dog.

By attending *Best Dog Day Ever* (the “**Event**”), Dog Parent warrants that they have read, understand, accept, and agree to adhere to the following terms of participation (the “**Terms**”). Attending the Event constitutes acknowledgment and acceptance of the Terms and failure to adhere to the Terms will result in removal from the Event.

1. Dog Control and Leashing. Dogs must remain leashed at all times. No Dog Parent shall cause or allow such dog(s) to be unleashed or unrestrained at the Event. No Dog Parent shall cause or allow such dog(s) to be out of control at the Event under any circumstances. Violation of this paragraph will result in immediate removal from the Event.

2. Licenses and Vaccinations. Properly licensed dogs, wearing a current license tag and vaccinated against rabies pursuant to the laws of the State of New York and City of New York and restrained by a leash or other restraint not exceeding six feet in length may be brought into the Event. Nothing in this paragraph shall be construed to prohibit persons with disabilities from bringing service animals into the Event as authorized by federal, state, or city law.

3. Additional Responsibilities. Dog Parent is solely responsible for the safety and supervision of their dog(s). No dogs may be unsupervised at any time.

3.1 Dog Parent is solely responsible for their dog(s)’ behavior and will be held liable for any injuries, damages, or loss caused by their dog(s) at the Event.

3.2 Dog Parent will use their own discretion in determining the level of participation of their dog(s) at the Event relating but not limited to which activities their dog(s) may participate in, which other dogs and/or people their dog(s) may interact with, and which treats may or may not be safe for their dog(s) to consume. It is the responsibility of the Dog Parent to decide if a situation at the Event may be too stressful, harmful, dangerous, and/or uncomfortable for their dog(s).

3.3 Dog Parent will make best efforts to guide their dog(s) to the designated dog relief area, but in the event the dog has an accident, Dog Parent will be responsible for cleaning up after their dog by collecting and disposing of any and all waste.



4. Assumption of Risk. Dog Parent acknowledges that attendance at the Event is voluntary and that by attending the Event, they assume all risk and legal liability of injuries, damages, and/or loss to themselves and/or their dog(s) and Dog Parent waive and release all claims relating (but not limited to) those injuries, damages, and/or loss.
