OFFICER REPORT

NARRATIVE

On Thursday 08/15/2013 at approximately 2048 hours, myself, Officer Pat Deveau and Sergeant Jeff Callahan were dispatched to [REDACTED] on a report of a family disturbance and loud commotion.

As I was driving to the scene I was updated by dispatch that a male had a knife and was stabbing a female in the chest. Upon my arrival I met with Officer Deveau. I had my department issued weapon drawn as both of us ran to apartment 1203. As, we ran up a small grassy hill approaching the apartment, a well built male emerged from the porch area with his hands up in the air and covered in blood. The male was not wearing a shirt and his socks were saturated with blood. REMY also had a small laceration to his head and a laceration to his right hand. Myself and Officer Deveau, with our weapons drawn, immediately ordered the male to the ground. He complied. He was lying face down with his hands behind his back. I recognized the male that emerged as Jared REMY. As he was recently arrested for domestic assault and battery with a dangerous weapon on 08/13/13.

While REMY was handcuffed, Sergeant Callahan arrived along with the fire department. Sergeant Callahan secured the scene. I observed from the sidewalk, just outside of the patio, a female lying face-up on the ground. She had what appeared to be multiple stab wounds to her front left shoulder area as well as wounds to her neck. The victim did not have a top on as it may have been removed during the struggle. She also had what appeared to be a blue cloth covering her face. It also appeared there was a substantial amount of blood on the ground surrounding the victims head and upper torso area. It was at this time the victim was identified as Jennifer MARTEL. MARTEL was motionless, not breathing, and appeared to be deceased due to her injuries and the large amount of blood. Cataldo attended to MARTEL who was pronounced dead at the scene at 2104 hours. CPAC and the Medical examiners office were notified and responded.

Sergeant Callahan had Officer Michel taped off the crime scene with yellow crime scene tape. Detective Comeau was on scene taking photos of the scene.

Officer Pat Deveau searched REMY for any weapons and property. What was found was a soft black sunglasses case that contained a diamond ring with a large round center stone and 2 smaller round baguettes on either side. Detective Comeau took photos of both items. I took possession of both items and they have been bagged and submitted as evidence. Once it was determined that REMY would be transported to the station, I radioed to dispatch to send the police wagon, as REMY was large and would not fit in the back of a police cruiser. He was subsequently transported to the station by Officer Aucoin with Officer Deveau riding in the rear with REMY. Officer Harry Michel followed the police wagon to the station.

I learned that there was a 4 year old female that was at the scene at the time of the incident. She was tended to inside the residence by Officers John Quaranto and Danielle Henderson (See Officer Henderson's report). The 4 year old female appeared unharmed and was subsequently transported to the Newton-Wellesley Hospital as a precaution. Officer Henderson went to the hospital with the female.

Sergeant Callahan told me to start a log of who was currently on scene and who arrived on scene. I then went to the apartment 1202 and spoke with the reporting witness as well as a second witness. The reporting witness was identified by her MA drivers license as Kristina FLICKINGER. The male witness was identified by his MA drivers license as Benjamin RAY of apartment 1108. I advised both witnesses that a detective would be speaking to them shortly and for them to remain close to the scene. I then went back to ensure that the scene remained secured and relieved Officer Deveau. Below is a listing of who was present during this incident and approximate times of arrival:

REMY was booked by Sergeant Scarpone without incident. After the booking process, REMY was transported to Lahey Clinic in Burlington for his injuries sustained at the scene.
