My name is Ryan Bausch. I am an FBI analyst assigned to the National Gang Intelligence Center. I am attempting to gain a national perspective on Juggalo activity within the United States in an effort to identify current threats and trends. I have narrowed down the areas in which Juggalo activity was initially reported when the National Gang Threat Assessment was submitted. In order to get a better sense of the emerging threats and trends associated with Juggalos, I am reaching out to areas where this gang is already established or has migrated to in the last couple of years. Below are the questions most pertinent to my research. Thank you for any assistance.

I am looking for information regarding any criminal activity in your AOR that is Juggalo-related. Do the documented Juggalo gangs in your area have an established name to represent their group (Killer Klownz, Juggalo Rydas, etc.)? How organized are they as a gang? Is there an established hierarchy or leadership roles? What types of crimes are they committing? Do they identify themselves as a gang? What is the typical age/race of the members? Do they have any rivals or alliances? How long has this gang been a problem? Are you seeing any unusual or new trends? Are there any areas outside of your immediate jurisdiction that you know this gang has a presence? If yes, please identify the respective location.

Thank you again for taking the time to answer these questions. This information will be analyzed in order to monitor the growing Juggalo migrations, identify emerging trends in other parts of the United States, and help to better understand the dynamic evolution of this emerging STG.

Attached is an after action on the clearing of the abandoned building at 1605 Bellevue.

There are 2 issues of any significance:

- 1) Juggalo graffiti was inside, associated with "187 on a... cop"
- 2) City youth outreach declined to come to the scene to assist. They stated they would rather be notified before a police operation so they can warn the youth that police are coming.

Apart from the safety issue that creates for us, its not clear to me how assisting us in an effort of this kind harms their credibility—something they feared it might. Instead, it would have supported our efforts to build bridges to this at risk population and demonstrated that we were really trying to help, not just take enforcement action.

Situation

The Marion Apartments is a vacant four-story building located at 1605 Bellevue Avenue, Seattle 98122. On October 27, 2008 the three north end apartment units consisting of one unit on each of the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors were extensively damaged by fire. Since the fire the building has been vacant and consistently ravaged by transient squatters and opportunists stripping the building of copper wiring, pipes and anything of value. The interior of the building is damaged with doors and walls torn apart along with fire, smoke and water damage. Squatters inside the building have caused further damage.

The building manager has attempted on numerous occasions to secure the building to keep out the squatters. Seattle Police have responded to this building on numerous occasions to clear the building of squatters at the request of the property manager and for 911 calls. The first floor accesses to the building have been successfully secured. A recent access into the building by the squatters has been identified on the 2nd floor southeast corner of the building. The building manager is requesting the assistance of the Seattle Police Department in clearing the building of squatters in order to secure the 2nd floor access point.

Mission Objective

The Marion Apartment building located at 1605 Bellevue Avenue, Seattle 98122 is to be cleared of squatters at the request of the building property manager who will be on-site with a construction crew to open the building for officers and to secure the building after the building is cleared of squatters.

The clearing of the building is to be done by cooperation between East ACT and Day SWAT employing the techniques used in large building searches with East Bicycles and East CPT officers providing assistance as needed by the ACT and SWAT teams. When squatters are located within the building they will be escorted out and turned over to officers for identification and the issuance of a trespass admonishment.

Upon the completion of the clearing of the building, the building property manager and construction crew will secure the access used by the officers and the second floor access used by the squatters to enter the building.

The Field Incident Commander will maintain communications with the on duty Second Watch Commander to apprise him/her of any problems or requests for extra personnel if needed.

Chronological Summary

Briefing held on Thursday December 2nd at 1000 hours in the East ACT office. All units responded to 1605 Bellevue Avenue at 1030 hours where the property manager and construction crew were on site and had the building access open for officers. A second briefing was conducted before entering the building to perform the sweep of squatters.

Two squatters were located inside and removed from the building and turned over to the East Bicycle unit for identification and trespassing admonishment.

After the building was cleared and officers exited the building, the securing of the premise was turned over to the property manager at approximately 1100 hours.

A debriefing was conducted at the scene prior to officers being relieved by the sergeants and lieutenant at the scene.

Enforcement

No arrests, no offense report, no use of force.

Noteworthy situation, events, circumstances

Graffiti was located on the south first floor stairway wall:

*187 on a muthafuckin cop
zombhe is here now so you were warnded*

Also noted inside were numerous spray painting on different walls: *Juggalo*

Logistics



Youth Outreach Terry Hayes (206-684-0275) was contacted about providing social services to displaced squatters. Hayes was concerned about being present with the police during this operation due to losing any credibility with the youth. Youth Outreach prefers to warn the squatters beforehand that the police are coming. Eric Anderson director of Youth Development and Achievement would like to explore working with police in the future and having an outreach person post flyers on this vacant building tomorrow or the next day with information about drop in centers and meal programs.

Communications

Communications conducted on both State Ops 5 and East radio. Radio communications was notified beforehand of the operation and was provided with a list of participating officers along with call signs, serial numbers and radio numbers.

Critique

The operation went smoothly without any concerns or issues due to preplanning and adherence to officer safety procedures. The property manager is taking appropriate measures to secure all of the second floor access into the building.

SITUATION

MISSION

To protect life and property, preserve the peace, suppress illegal activities, and expedite the orderly flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic. Ensure the safety of all citizens in the City of Seattle. The priorities for this event will be life safety, incident stabilization, and property protection. The Seattle Police Department and Commanders recognize that they are bound by the Constitution of the United States, as well as State, local and Federal Laws.

CONCEPT OF OPERATION

The Marion Apartment building located at 1605 Bellevue Avenue, Seattle 98122 is to be cleared of squatters at the request of the building property manager who will be on-site with a construction crew to open the building for officers and to secure the building after the building is cleared of squatters.

The clearing of the building is to be done by cooperation between East ACT and Day SWAT employing the techniques used in large building searches with East Bicycles and East CPT officers providing assistance as needed by the ACT and SWAT teams. When squatters are located within the building they will be escorted out and turned over to officers for identification and the issuance of a trespass admonishment.

Upon the completion of the clearing of the building, the building property manager and construction crew will secure the access used by the officers and the second floor access used by the squatters to enter the building.

The Field Incident Commander will maintain communications with the on duty Second Watch Commander to apprise him/her of any problems or requests for extra personnel if needed.

Administration/Logistics:

Officers will wear the approved uniform of the day during this event. Officers will report equipped with a radio, charged battery, flashlight, helmet, gasmask and baton. Helmets, gasmasks and batons will be stored in an area that is readily available.

Communications will be done through East Radio for all event communications unless otherwise directed. All officers will remain on post until released by Lt. Guay.

Special considerations:

If a mass arrest situation is foreseen, the following general steps will be taken:

All arrest must be based upon individualized probable cause. Field documentation must be accurate and support the requirement that each arrest was made with probable cause.

Failure to Disperse

The group will be contained by officers on three sides, with one side open to the sidewalk. Once this is accomplished, an officer will be positioned on the opposite side of the crowd from the location of the officer responsible for giving the dispersal order. Give the order 3 times, with at least 1 minute between each order.

I am (title / name) of the Seattle Police Department. I am now issuing you a public safety order to disperse from this area. Your conduct is in violation of State and City law, and your failure to leave this area will now subject you to arrest for (appropriate statute i.e.: Failure to disperse)

After 5 minutes from the last dispersal order, officers will establish a police line along the open side of the containment area, and arrests will commence. Priority will be given to those subjects within the crowd who are talking on cell phones and radios or are using masks or other objects to conceal their identity.





There was a request for information to be provided in the Gang Bulletin in reference to the gang definition and the criteria used to confirm a gang member. RCW 28a.600.455(2) covers the school definition of a gang and RCW 9.94A.030(12) is the criminal definition.

RCW 28a.600.455(2) – School Gang definition

Gang means a group which: (a) Consists of three or more persons; (b) has identifiable leadership; and (c) on an ongoing basis, regularly conspires and acts in concert mainly for criminal purposes.

RCW 9.94A.030(12) – Criminal Gang definition

Criminal street gang means any ongoing organization, association, or group of three or more persons, whether formal or informal, having a common name or common identifying sign or symbol, having as one of its primary activities the commission of criminal acts, and whose members or associates individually or collectively engage in or have engaged in a pattern of criminal street gang activity.

RCW 9.94A.030(13) – Criminal Gang associate or member definition

Criminal street gang associate or member means any person who actively participates in any criminal street gang and who intentionally promotes, furthers, or assists in any criminal act by the criminal street gang.

Gang confirmation matrix

This is the gang confirmation matrix used by both SCSO and Everett PD. SCSO, like Spokane, uses the three of nine to confirm a gang member (and one must be either 1,2 or 3) but Everett PD uses the two of nine (but at least one must be 1,2 or 3), which mirrors WSIN and Gang Net for their entry standards.

An Individual is considered a confirmed gang member when that individual meets 2 or more of the criteria listed below and at least one of those criteria must be #1, #2 or #3.

Executive Summary

The likelihood of a destructive terrorist act within the Puget Sound metropolitan region (Seattle-Bellevue-Everett-Tacoma) during a scheduled New Year's Eve celebration event remains unknown. While terrorism risk changes over time as terror group motives, opportunities and capabilities adapt to risk mitigation efforts; there is no credible or substantiated evidence known as of 28 December 2010 of any significant terror action directed against the Puget Sound community during New Year's Eve celebrations.

However, the absence of specific information does not discount the possibility of a threat. The risk posed by terrorism is dynamic and requires precautionary vigilance while attending large populated events.

Given the Puget Sound metropolitan region is Washington State's magnet for attracting the largest population and highest concentration of New Year's Eve partygoers and remains an identifiable 'type' of target (e.g. large public gatherings) for terror groups, **a generalized terror threat exists within the metropolitan area but it is unpredictable against the backdrop of a specific time, place or an event.**

A higher likelihood exists for **public exposure to safety risks from adverse gang interaction** and misdemeanor acts by opportunists with criminal intent. Historically, these incidents fueled by alcohol consumption result in public disturbances, impromptu demonstrations, thefts, and nuisances related to public intoxication, disorderly conduct and criminal mischief.

Key Judgments

Specific, credible, substantiated information

Most probable public safety threat: there is an **ELEVATED** threat risk posed by criminal acts manifesting from public disturbances, improvised demonstrations, thefts and nuisances related to public intoxication, disorderly conduct and mischief.

Most dangerous public safety threat: there is a **GUARDED** threat risk posed by violent gang interactions or indiscriminate shootings in or near large groups of revelers or bystanders. *While there is no credible or substantiated information related to an improvised explosive device being used, the Internet posting by extremists of radicalized forums have encouraged members to overwhelm law enforcement authorities and media outlets with "false threats" during the holiday season.*

Overview

Terrorism: holiday threats continue to be posted by various members of extremists online forums. The Intelligence Community recognizes these forums as well as other social media sites as having an essential role in recruiting and radicalizing the disenfranchised and disenchanting. Recently, threats posted on these forums have called upon members to attack US critical infrastructure such as electrical grid, water management and oil/gas pipeline distribution nodes. The intent is to damage or destroy the US economy as well as induce panic and mass hysteria. The continued posting of threats may motivate extremists, domestic and international, to attack the Homeland; which compels identifying large public attended holiday events and festivities as ideal targets. Further, the tactics suggested by extremists in radical forums such as “false threat” calls could be random acts to overwhelm first responders or could be diversionary calls to cover-up for another intended terror incident.

Opportunists with criminal intent:

- Within the Puget Sound metropolitan region, the increasing rise in the number of gangs and associated gang violence is problematic. Adverse gang interactions could emerge if turf affiliations are crossed or if gang members perceive disrespect from other gangs.
- There is a significant likelihood for impromptu public disturbances and street actions following the conclusion of the Space Needle fireworks show as revelers exit Seattle Center and head south through the Belltown area and to parts of Pioneer Square.
- The most recent public threat spotlight is on shopping malls. All major malls in the Puget Sound region will be opened 10:00am until 5 or 6:00pm on Friday, 31 December 2010. The holiday shopping opportunity on New Year’s Eve could encourage sizeable crowds.
- The most problematic opportunist is the so-called lone wolf. A challenge exists to reinforce public perception of safety in large populated events.

Gangs: While there is no credible or substantiated evidence indicating a direct targeted gang threat, there exists contemporary reporting of suspicious and problematic acts reflecting known aspects of gang tactics, techniques and precedence related to turf affiliation, gang identification issues and member’s retribution.





2010 New Year's Eve Threat Gauge











2010 New Year's Eve Threat Gauge
