On the 6th of April 1992, as a result of information from one Terry McLOUGHLIN and one , Teina PORA was nominated by them as a suspect in the homicide.

statement outlined the fact that she had had a conversation with , Teina, in which he had admitted having intercourse with the victim and that his mate had killed her.

Teina PORA was initially interviewed by myself at about 12.30am on the 7th of April 1992. A statement was obtained from PORA where he denied the allegations that had made.

statement was corroborated slightly by who also claimed that Teina had made certain disclosures about the homicide.


During the enquiry Teina PORA was nominated by other members of the PORA extended family and friends.

As a result of this on the 28th of May 1992, Teina PORA, PORA and were reinterviewed. Teina PORA continued to deny the allegations of , and it was obvious that one of the two was lying. During the reinterview of , she eventually admitted that her original statement was incorrect to the extent that she had conspired with her Aunties, Terry McLOUGHLIN, and to concoct a story implicating Teina PORA. The motive for this was that neither Aunty approves of Teina's criminal behaviour and they all wanted him placed in prison and out of their way.

It appears that _____ was the lesser party and is dominated by Terry McLOUGHLIN.

I suggest that no further action be taken in relation to Teina
_____ as a suspect or investigating further the false information
and conspiracy by _____ and her Aunties. There has already
been enough Police resources wasted in relation to this matter.
