

Kindly request for New Zealand Government from Sri Lankan Asylum Seekers

Sir,

We was trying to come to your country for Asylum from (54 Sri Lankan, 10 Bangladesh, and 01 myanmar) as to what we do let you attention.

In our country not safety for our life Thats why we leave our country for a few months. We stay in Indonesia by Asylum Seekers. Then hope you (New Zealand) can give Asylum and you also can give a peaceful life for us.

After 05-05-2015 early morning we started our Journey by boat (65 persons). 12 days. We make well travel on International Sea. Then 17-05-2015 evening Australian customs they to stop our Journey and they clamber boat. Then they search our Gps, Satelite phone maps, Gps points, foods, oil etc.

They confirm that we are going to New Zealand. That's why they give us a notice that "you don't try to come in Australia and don't try to use Australia Water area also" After that they were leave our boat.

Then we again our Journey for New Zealand without loosing our hope. Again after six days 22-05-2015 evening the Australian customs and Navy come back. They take away our captain on their ship and and more six hours secretly they talk with our captain. After finished their meeting that night Navy captain. Then they called all Asylum Seekers. Clamber on our boat then they called all Asylum Seekers for sitting in front of they called all Asylum Seekers for sitting in front of them. That time strongly training. So we came for sailors cabin. That time permission for go inside. But they were sick want permission for go inside. But they were not allowed. In morning we'll asked them that "where not allowed". But they didn't answered. You want to take us? But they didn't answered. Few days after we reached near North Australia. Then they send us inside Navy ship which was like a jail. Till that (time) day to until 31-05-2015 we stay that ship jail.

That time they take our profile with photo. In there we don't have any other dress ~~for~~ change until two days. They didn't tell anything after we make a unfood fast for the good answer. Then they told that they give good decision and we also believe their speech. Then we just wait for their good decision but they cheat with us. We never expect that.

Then they separate our six sailors and donated them by giving at least 7200 (Asu) dollars per person. They never ask to us any opinions and they also never accept our petitions.

Then they take away our better boat and give two small boats. That boat had just a little day foods like biscuits and chocklets, and they also give very little fuel just 200 ~~liters~~ liters for 4 to 5 hours Journey. Then they troll our boats and they leave us near Indonesian land. After that our captain drive our boats one hour later one boat fuel finished. We all jump to another small boat. After sailor also escape from the boat we don't know anything. After that our boat crashed on rock then we don't have any other ways. We jump over the boat to sea and swim more than 1 1/2 hours for reach island. When reached at the island some people get liked. So the village people help us and they save our life. They also inform to Indonesian Police. Until now we are staying there.

So we expect New Zealand Government
Rescuse our Peeling and give us Asylum for us.
We also hope that they'll give a peaceful life for us!
