Re: ULP Statement of Facts

Thursday, June 25, 2015 I received a phone call from Akron City Councilwoman Tara Mosley- Samples. I did not answer the telephone and allow it to go to voicemail about 15 min. later I listened to the message that Councilwoman Samples left. She stated in her message that she had received information from one of AFSCME Local 1360 union members that attended the AFSCME Local 1360 Union membership meeting, in which I am the President and chairmen, held on Wednesday, June 24, 2015.

Ms. Samples stated in her message "I had gave the membership misleading information about a appointment to city Council in the Ward 10's open seat.

She went on the say that I was wrong in my statements to my membership and I should've contacted her before I gave any information on the outcome of that appointment. She made statements saying the appointee Jack Hefner was not qualified and she had no information on him to make a sound decision"

I then received a phone call from AFSCME Local 1360 Grievance Chairman and Board Member Garland Paynther who informed me that Councilwoman Tara Mosley-Samples had just called him on his cell phone attempting to discuss what she was told that was said at our union meeting, I then realize she had cross the line violating the contract (Article II; Management Rights and Article III; Union Recognition also creating an unfair labor practice, ORC 4117.03, (A); Protected Activities.

I then sent her a text, I stated "from where we stand it is what it is and from where most of us union reps see it there is nothing to talk about your, reasoning has no merit".

Ms. Mosley-Samples, replied in a texting, "I will be sending an e-mail because what has been replied to your members is not true the process was flawed and not one union person called saying support Hefner".

My reply, "ok. But what is talked about in our union meetings with other union members are the business of the union".

On Friday, June 26, 2015 Councilwoman Mosley-Samples made good on her threat, she sent out an e-mail stating "I am sending you all the attached letter with great concern and would appreciate a call or a response to this matter".

The above named e-mail along with the letter are enclosed with this statement of facts.



Councilwoman Samples believes I made certain statement at our closed door union meeting. If I ever had to prove what was stated in any of our meetings I can do so without a shadow of a doubt. I am confident that my comments where will within my rights and respectful to the issue at our union meeting on Wednesday, June 24, 2015

This is not the first time that Councilwoman Samples has misused her authority in relationship to AFSCME Local 1360.

When pushing for a resolution to reduce the criteria for felons to be hired within the City of Akron, Councilwoman Mosley-Samples stated on the floor of Akron City Council that George Johnson and Garland Panther supported this resolution.

Myself and Mr. Panther never told Councilwoman Mosley-Samples or anyone else that we were supporting that resolution.

This statement is in regards to a phone call received by Garland L. Paynther from Councilwoman Tara Mosey-Samples on June 25, 2015 approximately 5:54 pm. This phone call lasted approximately 8 minutes and 38 seconds. Mrs. .Samples stated in her call that " A member called her after our membership meeting June 24, 2015 stating that President George Q. Johnson was telling members not to vote for her and other Council people". I then corrected her and told her that wasn't true and the only thing discussed in that meeting in regards to City Council was How the Vote went for Ward 10 Councilman and who voted yea or nay . I also told MRS. Mosely-Samples whomever called her with that information was wrong. She went on to say if "George Q. Johnson said this he was wrong". And went on to say that "no one gave her MR. Hefner information or resume and that Eric Garrett was more qualified for the Ward 10 Councilman". I stated "No he isn't "and then Mrs. Mosely-Samples ended conversation saying she had to go and would call me back she didn't call me back. Council Woman Mosely-Samples contacted me via e-mail Friday June 26, 2015 and Monday June 29, 2015 (see attached emails and letter). What Council woman Mosely-Samples doesn't understand is that I am obligated by my Local ,Council 8 and International Constitutions to serve my membership in the capacity of Grievance Chairman I do not and cannot over ride anything a sitting President says or does . And the realm of politics doesn't play a part in any of those Constitutions. Nor do I have to justify or explain what goes on to any City cabinet member in our membership meetings at any time.
