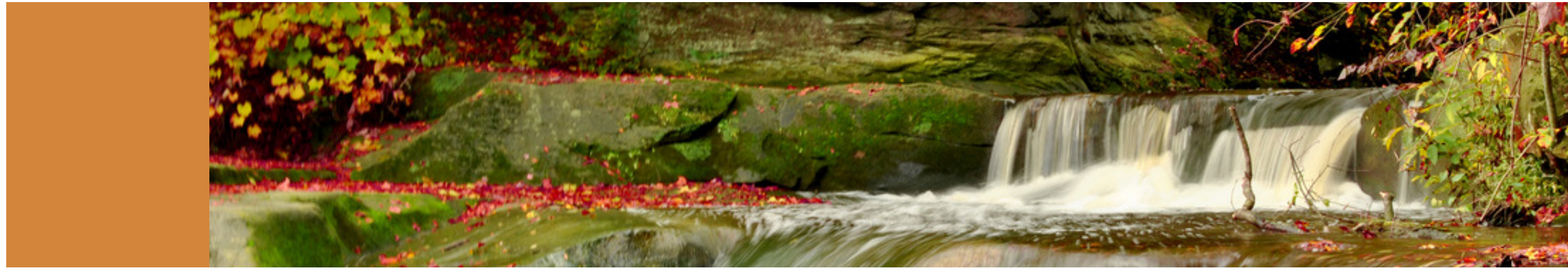
Vision for Quality Government
