

## 2012 Election Cycle at a Glance

- JStreetPAC distributed **over \$1.8 million** to its 71 endorsed candidates — the most in history by a pro-Israel PAC.
- **70 of 71** JStreetPAC endorsed candidates **won their races**, including all 53 incumbents.
- **50% more** JStreetPAC endorsed senators and congressmen are serving in the 113th Congress than in the previous Congress.
- JStreetPAC endorsed **7 Senate candidates**, all of whom won their elections.
- JStreetPAC backed winning candidates in some of the most competitive Senate races in the country, raising more than **\$100,000 each** for Sen. Sherrod Brown (OH), Rep. Tammy Baldwin (WI), Gov. Tim Kaine (VA) and Rep. Martin Heinrich (NM). The PAC also raised **over \$95,000** for longtime pro-Israel stalwart and Chair of the Senate Select Committee on Intelligence Sen. Dianne Feinstein (CA).
- JStreetPAC was responsible for **35% of funds distributed** to candidates, and **50% of funds distributed** to Democratic candidates, by the 29 pro-Israel PACs in 2012.
- JStreetPAC endorsees in competitive races outperformed other candidates in tight contests — **the PAC won 20 of 21 races** that were categorized as competitive by the Cook Political Report.
- The PAC raised an average of **\$26,000 per candidate**.
- JStreetPAC endorsees **defeated six Members of Congress** who took particularly extreme positions on Israel, including opposing a two-state solution — a bloc we named the “One-State Caucus.”
