Here's some guidance in deciding when to give a magic check
toward a B-I-N-G-O in that box.

First decide if you liked what the candidate said about the
policy area in question. To answer that, consider:

- Does the policy solution presented boost the moms, dads, and families who are struggling?

- Does the policy/budgetary strategy advance gender & racial equity?
- Does the policy contribute to closure of the opportunity gap?
- Who most benefits and why from the policy solution? Who doesn't benefit? Why? What are the unintended consequences for moms, families, and communities of color?
- Did the candidate present a clear and convincing plan for how to achieve their strategy or policy goal?
