

Allegro Nextgen Reformer™ Jumpboards

ALLEGRO NEXTGEN - STANDARD JUMPBOARD

To install the standard jumpboard on your Allegro Nextgen, set up the trunnions:

1. Pull knobs outward and adjust footbar to the third position from the frame end. See Figure A.
2. Squeeze handles and adjust footbar to the third position from the top. See Figure A.

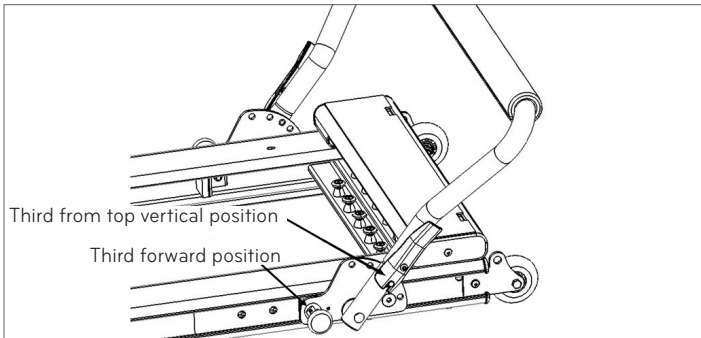

3. Install the jumpboard by lowering jumpboard between the footbar and frame, inserting the flange on the padded side of the jumpboard into the frame as shown in Figure B.

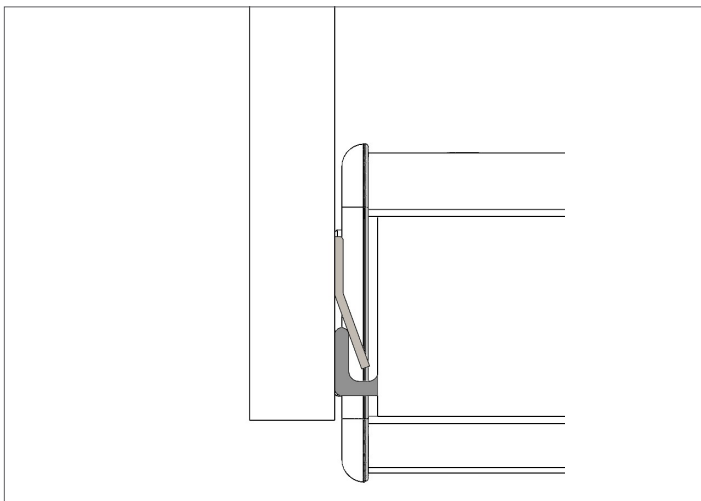

If there is a gap between the jumpboard and the footbar, a grey strip of foam is included that can be installed on the back of the jumpboard to fill the space (Figure B).

ALLEGRO NEXTGEN—JUMPUS MAXIMUS

To install the Jumpus Maximus on your Allegro Nextgen, set up the trunnions:

1. Pull knobs outward and adjust footbar to the end of the frame farthest from the carriage. See Figure C.
2. Squeeze handles and adjust footbar to the highest position. See Figure C.

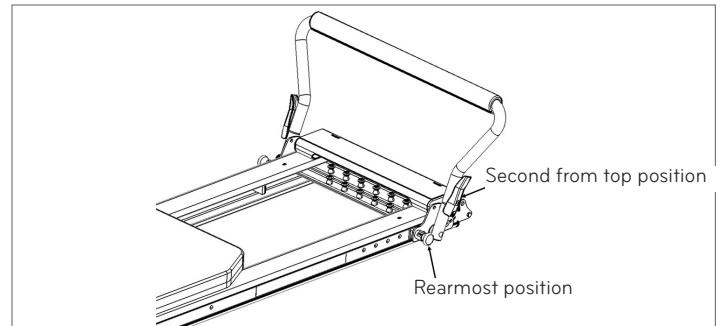

3. Install the jumpboard by lowering jumpboard between the footbar and frame, inserting the flange on the padded side of the jumpboard into the frame as shown in Figure B.

When installed correctly the padded jumpboard will be supported by the footbar (Figure D).

If there is a gap between the jumpboard and the footbar, a grey strip of foam is included that can be installed on the back of the jumpboard to fill the space.

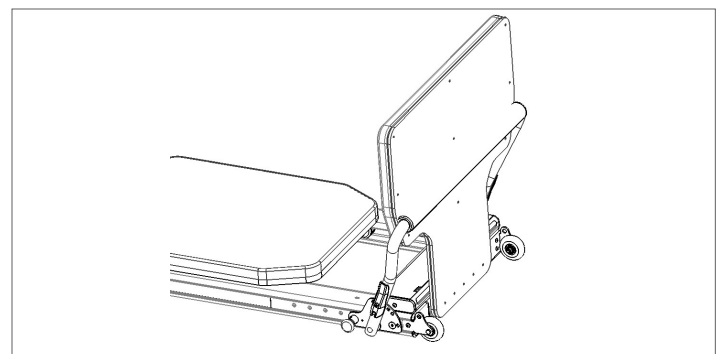
