

DID YOU KNOW?

OUR COLORADO CONSTITUTION STILL ALLOWS SLAVERY!

Article II, Section 26 states: "There shall never be in this state either slavery or involuntary servitude EXCEPT as a punishment for crime, whereof the party shall have been duly convicted."

Amendment A removes this language from our Colorado Constitution. Voting YES on Amendment A will change the constitution to say:



"THERE SHALL NEVER BE IN THIS STATE EITHER SLAVERY OR INVOLUNTARY SERVITUDE."
