
WHEREAS, National Public Lands Day activities can be shared on social media channels using the hashtags #NPSVolunteer, #FindYourPark, and #NPLD; and




NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada, on this 28th day of September, 2019 do hereby honor and recognize

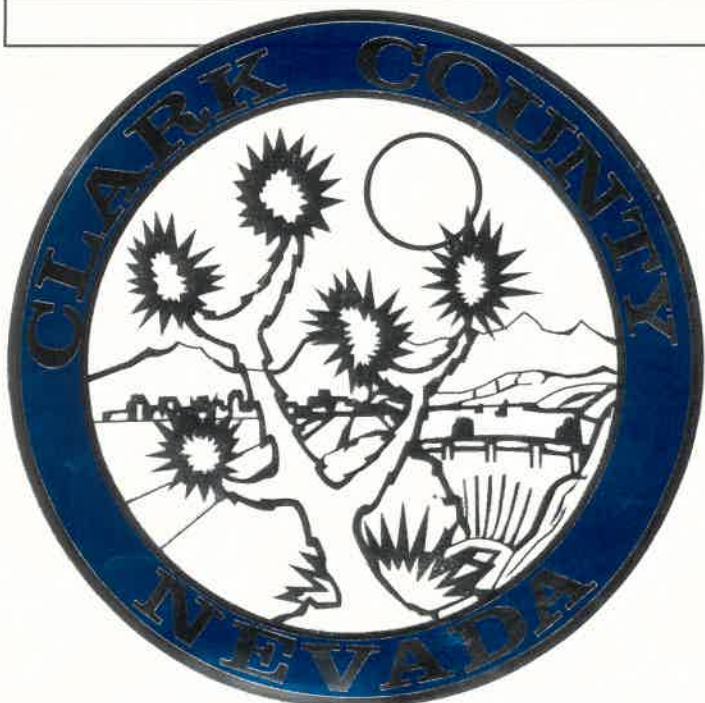


