

CALIFORNIA SEXUAL HARASSMENT PREVENTION TRAINING
Mandatory Enforcement for minors age 14-17 begins 06/30/2019

California recently passed a law (AB 2338) which requires 14-17 year old minors and their parent or legal guardian to complete training in sexual harassment prevention, retaliation and reporting resources. Compliance with the new law is scheduled to begin 06/30/2019.

In response to this immediate need, Children In Film has become a Certified Vendor for the State of California and has created a platform for families to receive the required training at a very low cost. If you have clients or employees who will turn 14 in the next six months and need to obtain or renew a California Entertainment Work Permit, this training is mandatory as of 06/30/2019 and permits will no longer be issued without it.
