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Description

The following installation instructions supplement is for the APG/GPG gas/electric package units. These instructions explain the installation of the Combustion Air Intake Hood and the Exhaust Flue Hood.

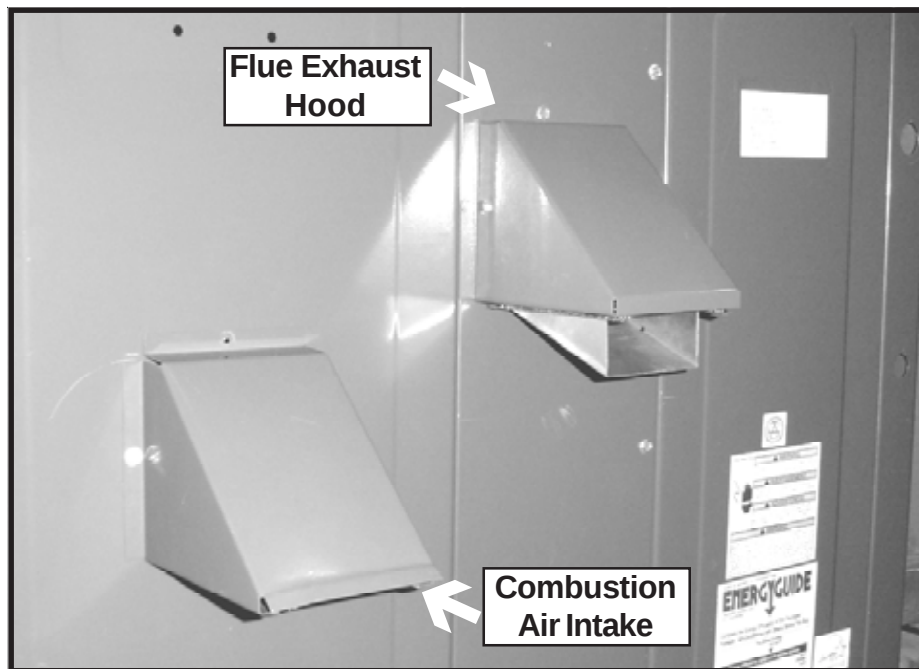

ATTENTION INSTALLING PERSONNEL

Safety is a matter of common sense...a matter of thinking before acting. Most dealers have a list of specific good safety practices...follow them.

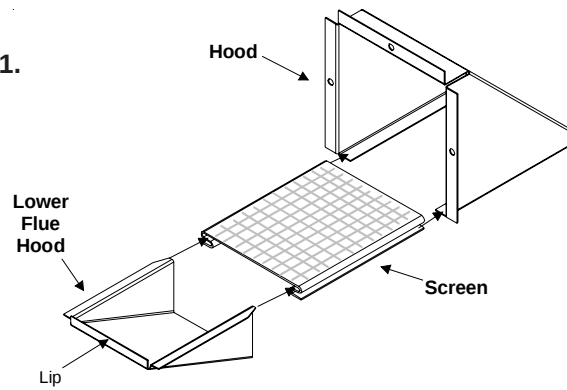
The precautions listed in this Installation Manual are intended as supplemental to existing practices.

However, if there is a direct conflict between existing practices and the content of this manual, the precautions listed here take precedence.

Installation - Flue Exhaust Hood

1. Locate the flue hood assembly box from the blower compartment.
2. Slide screen over flanges on the lower flue hood. (Figure 1).
3. Slide screen into hood.
4. Using the three screws provided, attach the hood (with the opening facing down) over the flue exhaust opening in the utility panel (Figure 2).

Installation - Combustion Air Intake Hood

1. Locate the second hood.
2. Using the three screws provided, attach the hood (with the opening facing down) to the heat exchanger access door (Figure 2).
