UW-PLATTEVILLE CAMPUS

UW-Platteville's campus encompasses 820 acres, including 64 buildings and the 430-acre Pioneer Farm. Eleven attractive and well-maintained residence halls provide accommodations for 3,400 students.

Platteville (population 11,000) is the tri-state (Iowa-Illinois-Wisconsin) area's second largest city and Wisconsin's largest community southwest of Madison. Platteville is 20 miles northeast of Dubuque, Iowa; 70 miles southwest of Madison; 150 miles west of Milwaukee; and 150 miles northwest of Chicago. A four-lane highway connects UW-Platteville to Madison, Iowa City, and Dubuque.
