FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

Saint Faustina is a Polish saint born in 1905. She later entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy where she devoted her life to prayer and caring for others. In the 1930's, Sister Faustina received a message of mercy from the Lord which she was told to spread throughout the world. This is how the prayerful devotion, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, began. Each day from Good Friday to Divine Mercy Sunday (the Sunday after Easter Sunday), the Divine Mercy novena is prayed.

The Divine Mercy Chaplet, led by members of the Spiritual Life Committee from Saint Andrew School, will be held in the Saint Andrew Church Chapel each day starting March 25 and ending April 2 from 3:00pm - 3:15pm. This devotion will conclude on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 3, with a celebration at San Mateo Catholic Church, 3304 Lovell Ave, 76107, from 2:00p.m. - 5:00p.m.




