**If the forfeiture is not resolved:**

As a direct result of the forfeiture of the right to transact business, the entity's officers, directors, partners, members or owners may be personally liable for debts of the entity (including taxes, penalties and interest) incurred after the due date of the report and/or payment. Also, the entity may be unable to sue or defend in a court of this state in accordance with the law.

Unless your entity's right to transact business is revived before 07/30/2018, the entity's registration with the Secretary of State will be forfeited. This notice is given in accordance with Texas Tax Code Sections 171.251, 171.2515, 171.252 and 171.256. **Note: The provisions in the law concerning forfeiture of the entity's right to transact business do not apply to banking corporations or savings and loan associations.**
