(see Appendix: "JS OLOO for Modern Game Development Method") I assume you (the reader) already know some of these technologies. If not, then a few hours spent on *W3Schools* can quickly remedy any deficiency and earn valuable certifications. *The workshop instructor's packaged edition* includes PowerPoint slides with lecture references available only from **LeanPub.com**.

This edition reveals different production methods which I call the *Game Design System*<sup>™</sup> — in which, we'll create *Game Recipes*<sup>™</sup> for specific "Game Mechanics". This workbook provides simple-to-follow worksheets, step-by-step instructions, and a straightforward approach to building specific Game Mechanics *from Construct components* using my *Game Design System*<sup>™</sup> methods discussed in the supporting "Code-less Game Construction" series.

Expert game developers understand the "Don't Repeat Yourself" (D.R.Y.) concept, yet few have taken a step back to the "10,000-foot view" on their own game production pipelines.
