STRUCTURE

Each service of Lauds, Tierce, Sext, None and Compline is divided into 8 sections:

1. Introduction Prayer
2. Canticle of the hour
3. Canticle of the Archangel of the day
4. Song of Solomon (fixed weekly cycle)
5. Psalm (choose 1 from 4 offered, the cycle completes in 28 days).
6. Prayer of the hour
(Te Deum Laudamus for Lauds
Our Father for Tierce
Angelus for Sext
Adore Te Devote for None
Gloria for Compline)
7. The Verse
8. Concluding Prayer

Vespers is divided into 10 sections:

1. Introduction Prayer
2. Canticle of the hour
3. Canticle of the Archangel of the day
4. Kyrie
5. Song of Solomon (fixed weekly cycle)
6. Psalm (choose 1 from 4 offered, the cycle completes in 28 days).
7. Daily Reading from Codex Lumea (or other lectionaries).

8. Prayer of the hour (Magnificat)
9. The Verse
10. Concluding Prayer

It is a marriage of the esoteric (Songs of Solomon) and the conventional (Psalms).

For a conventional experience the Songs of Solomon can be omitted.

Lauds – Canticle of the Rising Sun

Songs of Solomon

Song 1

You the lord are mingled in my hair like a crown,
and I shall never be without you.
This crown of truth was woven for me
and makes your branches blossom in me.
The crown is not dry and sterile.
You live and blossom across my head.
Your fruit is full, perfect, and mingled with salvation.

Psalms

(choose one from the selection, rotating through the choices)

Psalm 1. Beatus vir qui non abiit.

BLESSED is the man that hath not walked in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stood in the way of sinners, and hath not sat in the seat of the scornful.

2 But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law will he exercise himself day and night.

3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the water-side, that will bring forth his fruit in due season.

4 His leaf also shall not wither; and look, whatsoever he does, it shall prosper.

5 As for the ungodly, it is not so with them; but they are like the chaff, which the wind scatters away from the face of the earth.

6 Therefore the ungodly shall not be able to stand in the judgment, neither the sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

7 But the Lord knows the way of the righteous; and the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Psalm 37. Noli æmulari. Part 2

22 Such as are blessed of God, shall possess the land; and they that are cursed of him, shall be rooted out.

23 The Lord ordered a good man's going, and makes his way acceptable to himself.

24 Though he fall, he shall not be cast away; for the Lord upholds him with his hand.

25 I have been young, and now am old; and yet saw I never the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging their bread.

26 The righteous is ever merciful, and lends; and his seed is blessed.

27 Flee from evil, and do the thing that is good; and dwell forevermore.

28 For the Lord loves the thing that is right; he forsakes not his that be godly, but they are preserved forever.

29 The unrighteous shall be punished; as for the seed of the ungodly, it shall be rooted out.

30 The righteous shall inherit the land, and dwell therein forever.

31 The mouth of the righteous is exercised in wisdom, and his tongue will be talking of judgment.

32 The law of his God is in his heart, and his goings shall not slide.

33 The ungodly watches the righteous, and seeks occasion to slay him.

34 The Lord will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.

35 Hope thou in the Lord, and keep his way, and he shall promote thee, that thou shalt possess the land: when the ungodly shall perish, thou shalt see it.

36 I myself have seen the ungodly in great power, and flourishing like a green bay-tree.

37 I went by, and lo, he was gone: I sought him, but his place could no where be found.

38 Keep innocency, and take heed unto the thing that is right; for that shall bring a man peace at the last.

39 As for the transgressors, they shall perish together; and the end of the ungodly is, they shall be rooted out at the last.

40 But the salvation of the righteous comes of the Lord; who is also their strength in the time of trouble.
41 And the Lord shall stand by them, and save them: he shall deliver them from the ungodly, and shall save them, because they put their trust in him.

Psalm 73. Quam bonus Israel! Part 1

TRULY God is loving unto Israel: even unto such as are of a clean heart.

2 Nevertheless, my feet were almost gone, my treadings had well-nigh slipt.

3 And why? I was grieved at the wicked: I do also see the ungodly in such prosperity.

4 For they are in no peril of death; but are lusty and strong.

5 They come in no misfortune like other folk; neither are they plagued like other men.

6 And this is the cause that they are so holden with pride, and cruelty covered them as a garment.

7 Their eyes swell with fatness, and they do even what they lust.

8 They corrupt other, and speak of wicked blasphemy; their talking is against the Most High.

9 For they stretch forth their mouth unto the heaven, and their tongue goes through the world.

10 Therefore fall the people unto them, and thereout suck they no small advantage.

11 Tush, say they, how should God perceive it? is there knowledge in the Most High?

12 Lo, these are the ungodly, these prosper in the

world, and these have riches in possession:

13 And I said, Then have I cleansed my heart in vain,
and washed my hands in innocency.

Psalm 104. Benedic, anima mea. Part 2

16 The trees of the Lord also are full of sap; even the
cedars of Lebanon which he hath planted;

17 Wherein the birds make their nests; and the fir-trees
are a dwelling for the stork.

18 The high hills are a refuge for the wild goats; and
so are the stony rocks for the hyraxes.

19 He appointed the moon for certain seasons, and the
sun knows his going down.

20 Thou makes darkness that it may be night; wherein
all the beasts of the forest do move.

21 The lions, roaring after their prey, do seek their
meat from God.

22 The sun arises and they get them away together,
and lay them down in their dens.

23 Man goes forth to his work, and to his labour, until
the evening.

24 O Lord, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom
hast thou made them all; the earth is full of thy riches.

Psalm 119 xix. Clamavi in toto corde meo.

I CALL with my whole heart; hear me, O Lord; I will
keep thy statutes.

146 Yea, even unto thee do I call; help me, and I shall
keep thy testimonies.

147 Early in the morning do I cry unto thee; for in thy word is my trust.

148 Mine eyes prevent the night watches; that I might be occupied in thy word.

149 Hear my voice, O Lord, according unto thy loving kindness; quicken me, according to thy judgments.

150 They draw nigh that of malice persecute me, and are far from thy law.

151 Be thou nigh at hand, O Lord; for all thy commandments are true.

152 As concerning thy testimonies, I have known long since, that thou hast grounded them forever.
