


Day 1: Self Portrait Metaphor


Date: April 1st, 2020

we begin again








Day 4: From a Dream


Date: April 4th, 2020Prompt: Write about a specific image from a DreamInspiration(s): A dead ballerina, dressed in gold, surrounded by butterflies

in a tomb of gold tule













he'll end up dead









Day 14: Poetic Inspiration




she carries buckets of stars among gardens of flowers and tends to each, the good & the bad
