What is Inventors Challenge?

Usually, family members and friends commented about how successfully I will be, but two things made me shift from talking about the ideas to actually making plans with them. One, I saw my idea on television and I was so upset at myself for waiting so long and not doing anything about it and two, a good friend figuratively slapped me upside my head and told me to go after those ideas myself. So, since then I have been doing that. Though I have not fulfilled my greatest goals, yet, I am still striving. Now fast forward to 2013. I was reading an amazing article about Quirky in Inc. magazine on the 12 day of November 2013 and that same day I joined Quirky and I have been hooked ever since. Inventors Challenge came about as a way to stay motivated while creating new ideas on a consistent basis. It is something that I made up for myself, but I am gladly introducing the concept to the world so that others could start their own challenge. The challenge is simple, simply set a goal of how many ideas you will come up with within a certain time frame. For me, I would set my goal at 30 ideas within a month or basically one idea a day for 30 days. Whatever goal you set, you must seek to accomplish it within the time

frame. I am developing an app that helps in setting and accomplish those goals. Book two of inventors challenge will cover it in details.


Tip 1: Idea Generation

This could be the hardest part of creating an idea for some, while for others it is the easiest. For me, creating ideas is simple, it just literally pop up consistently. For awhile it used to drive me crazy because I am creating all these ideas but unable to do anything with them. I tried those invention companies who promise to help you, I tried contacting a television program that has investors who are willing to help you in your invention, but to be honest I am glad that that did not work out, because it turns out that even if they do not help you financially, because you were on the show and you mention your products name, you will have to pay them a certain amount of the profits from your products profits for life. That is really really wrong, but hey, before people knew about Quirky, they did not have many options. So in continuing, if you are not blessed with the ability to just create ideas, do not be discouraged because you could develop that skill. You have to literally put your mind in a state of seeking to help make yourself, the lives of your family and friends and the world a better place. When you do that, you will see, hear, smell, taste, and touch solutions. For example, let us look at the idea that I had that was brought to the market by someone else. My idea was a simple ladies handbag that enabled the user to have multiple bags without removing the items from bag to bag on different occasions. All they had to do was change the

the outer layer of their handbag. Having plenty of ladies in my family and plenty of female friends, I noticed that they always had plenty of bags and I really felt bad for them when it was time for them to go anywhere because of all the things that they had to rearrange, etc. So my mind created a solution of having the one inner layer and then they could use the multiple outer layers with various designs. So that has been my mindset and I encourage you to keep that mindset as well, a creative solution mindset.

Invention 1 (Jelly/Butter Secure)

Making a sandwich will never be a chore again. No more sliding jars of peanut butter, jelly, or another spread.

The Problem

When was the last time you made a sandwich, whether for yourself or someone else? Was it time consuming to make or was it a cinch to make. I was making a peanut butter sandwich with the bread in one hand the knife in another. While trying to scoop the peanut butter, i was delayed because the container kept on sliding on the table.


I had to ask someone to hold the container for me.

The Solution

My product solves this problem by enabling the container (weather peanut butter, jelly, hummus, etc) to have a secure foundation so that the user could scoop without the container sliding all over the table. And because it is secured, the use would be able to get a good size scoop instead of a little at a time, therefore taking less time to make each sandwich.

The Problem

Hospitals have limited visiting hours and sometimes when you make it in time the patient is resting. They are not able to get all the well wishes that would help them to get better soon. In an article by Angela Epstein, from the Daily Mail, she stated that , "A close relationship with a friend, partner or relative has been found to halve the risk of heart patients having another cardiac arrest, while a lack of a close confidant puts sufferers at a greater risk of having further heart attacks." Imagine those who do have close confidants or friends. It is a serious problem when a person who is very sick goes to bed feeling sad and lonely.

The Solution

When a person visits and the loved one is sleeping or knocked out, the visitor could leave a personalized message for them. WHen they wake up, they could view and hear the message whenever they want. Precious Plays will address the patient's need for encouragement, love, reassurance and comfort. In turn the patient can have a full recovery with less of a likelihood of relapse. Ronnie Nathan, Chief Barker of the Variety Club, endorses the idea that love and kindness can help us recover from ill health. By the way, there are almost 6,000 hospitals in the United States alone and I could imagine, that all of them could benefit from this idea.

Invention 3 (Paci Phone)

You and your toddler could enjoy using a smartphone while helping the child in teething.

The Problem

Being a parent and holding your child is a joy. Now, imagine trying to check email, making a call, typing notes, etc. while holding your child. For me, my son tries to take the phone and sometimes when I give it to him, he places it in his mouth. If your phone gets drool damage, then it is done. Now, your child is teething and being able to help ease the pain is a joy for a parent.

The Solution

My idea will combine a pacifier with a photo frame that is shaped like a smartphone. The pacifier, of course, helps in his/her teething while the photo frame feature helps to keep his/her attention and makes it seem like they are using a phone. You could switch out your photo at any time and reseal it without worrying about the photo getting drool damage.

Tip 2: Do something about it.

So you have generated your ideas, so what is next? You must document it immediately, no waiting until tomorrow. Doing that is so important because you never know what might happen that causes you to forget what you envisioned. I am speaking from experience when I tell you that forgetting an awesome idea the next day could cause you a minor stress especially when it is something you believe is really good. In times past I used to write on notepads, which is good by the way, but we are in the digital age so I highly encourage you to use an app that keeps your notes. As a matter of fact, I use google keep on my phone, computer, and tablet. Every change is updated instantly on the server so that I could keep working on any device. You could also use evernote, but google keep is 100% free. Now that you have your ideas jotted down, I encourage you to start working on them one by one. Let us go back to Quirky. On Quirky, you are able to submit your idea into a variety of categories and after placing it you must first vote for yourself and then share your idea with your friends, family members and the rest of the world. Other Quirky users go through and view newly added ideas and vote for the ones that they like. Sometimes you will get users who will vote for yours and then ask you to vote for theirs, but that is another story altogether. If you get 200 votes, then your

idea gets reviewed and the door could opened wide for it to become an invention. But before you submit your idea, you need to make sure that your idea have a title, a good explanation of the problem and the solution. Also, a very good drawing or 3d sketch really helps as well. There are very good programs out there that help with the graphic design but I will share some of the free ones. First there is Gimp, it is like photoshop but 100% free. Next there is Inkscape, it is like Illustrator but 100% free. There are plenty of expensive, yet very good 3d programs, but I will only mention a free good one. 123d Design is from Autodesk and it is a program that I am learning right now. You could use the 3d program to sketch out your design in the submitting stage or you could use your skills and create a design later on after your idea is chosen and the Quirky community is working together to put everything together such as design, name, tagline, color, etc. In book two I will go into detail with tips on naming a product, taglines, and research etc.

Invention 4 (Disposable Drool Guard)

The Problem


Your infant needs burping and your wife is tired after feeding him/her. There are times when the infant vomits

My idea solves this problem by having a wrapped cloth around your neck and upper body that is almost like a bib, but for front and back (More like a half t-shirt, but it is leak proof. And because it is disposable, you could give one to a visiting family member or friend to help in burping the baby.

Interlocking Spice Set


Separated: At home


The Solution

The Problem



Ideally, I would like for the device to be simple, small and waterproof. - 4. Most covers are just to cover and that is it, no use other than covering. The Solution


