
One sunny afternoon, while exploring the attic of Mia's grandmother's house,

"Run!" Leo shouted.




They sprinted through the forest, the roots chasing them. Just as they



ever.




1. "If you could invent anything, what would it be? I'd make a robot that does homework... but only after we finish our adventure!"


