Distinguished as “Chicagoan of the Year in Classical Music” by the Chicago Tribune, *Vladimir Kulenovic* is recognized among the finest conductors of his generation. Engagements include the symphonies of Chicago, San Francisco, Houston, Indianapolis, Utah, Omaha, Bonn, Leipzig, and Taipei; the national orchestras of France, Spain, Basque, and NAC/Ottawa; as well as the philharmonic orchestras of Reutlingen, Malaysia, Minas Gerais, Slovenia and Zagreb, among others. Festival appearances include Verbier, Aspen, Mozarteum, Cabrillo, Kuhmo and Round Top.

Mr. Kulenovic has been Music Director of the Lake Forest Symphony, Associate Conductor of the Utah Symphony, Resident Conductor of the Belgrade Philharmonic, and Principal Conductor of the Kyoto Festival. Commercial discography includes CDs on the Cedille, Törö, and Slovenia-RTV labels.

Awards received by Mr. Kulenovic include the highest Solti Conducting Award, the Bruno Walter Award, Juilliard's Schiff Prize, and the Second Grand-Prix at the Rubinstein Piano Competition in Paris. He was honored by the League of American Orchestras to be a participant in the 2013 Bruno Walter National Conducting Preview. Vladimir Kulenovic is a graduate of The Juilliard School, where he studied with James DePriest, and the Peabody Institute of Johns Hopkins University, where he studied with Gustav Meier.
