**Tie Breakers:**

1. Head to Head
2. Best record in Division (not applicable in 2015)
3. Total Runs scored between the teams that are tied (head to head)
4. Zimanske Rule - Assign points to each team in the final standings and add up the points earned based on victories over those teams  
Zimanske Points: Every team you beat, you get points equalling the number of wins they have at end of season. Wins against Elko = Elko's Win % X 23 games

NM had tie breaker over Faribault; NM #1 Seed, Faribault # 2 Seed (Head to Head)

St. P had tie breaker over UH (Head to Head tied, Total Runs)

Lons (4-2), Mont (4-2), NP (2-4), and PL (2-4) Head to Head; Lon 2-0 H2H over Mont; NP/PL tied H2H, Tied Runs, and NP beats PL with Zimanske Pts

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**Tie Breaking Methodology:**

Rule 1: A given tie-breaker rule applies equally to all the teams that are tied at a specified record.

Rule 2: If, after the application of a given tie-breaker, all of the teams are still tied, go to the next tie breaker

Rule 3: If not all teams, but one or more subgroups of the teams are tied, separate these teams into groups and go back to rule 1 with each of the groups individually

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
