

DRS League Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order by President, Jerry Walerius. Roll call showed all teams present.

Chris Hertaus submitted the treasurer's report. The report showed the league is in good financial shape with a balance of \$2,566.60. There is one outstanding invoice from Nicholson Athletic, but that will be covered once teams pay the league for their baseball orders. Eight teams still owe. Please get the payments handled.

There was no old business. Next up Ned from KCHK explained their broadcast plans for 2010. All teams will be featured at least twice. They will also cover the All-Star Game.
