

RVL vs DRS All-Star Game Rules

- The Host League is the Home Team
- Pitchers are limited to 2 innings, other than the starting pitcher that can pitch 3 innings or unless the game goes extra innings.
- Unlimited Re-Entry Rule: Meaning that any player that is inserted into the line-up can re-enter in that same spot in the batting order.
 - Thus starters and non-starters can re-enter.
 - This gives managers more flexibility. And managers do not have to worry about injuries as anyone that has been in that slot of the batting order can re-enter into the game.
- Courtesy Runners are allowed for Pitchers and Catchers
- A one-time courtesy runner is also allowed for a non-pitcher or non-catcher
 - The one-time courtesy runner gives the opportunity for an older or injured player to bat and be relieved of base-running responsibilities.
 - Any courtesy runner cannot have been in the game previously. And the courtesy runner does not actually enter on the lineup card---per high school league rules.
- Strict slide rules are to be discussed and enforced. These rules are to be discussed during ground rules and also with the team members before the game. Nobody should be injured on the offensive or defensive teams due to a collision at any base.
