

How Do I Upload a Video to Kaltura?

Kaltura, found at https://video.byui.edu, is BYU-Idaho's official video hosting platform. Instructors may upload course-related videos to Kaltura and place them in their courses.

Add New



Click the button labeled "Add New."

Login



If prompted to do so, enter your BYU-Idaho login credentials.


Upload Media

Click the button labeled "Choose a file to upload."

Find the Video




- 1. Browse your computer until you find the video file you'd like to upload.
- 2. Click Open.

Enter Title & Description



Give your video a title and description.

Enter Tags



Enter keyword tags that may help you or your students find this video using a search engine.

Choose Lifespan of Video



Choose the duration of time you'd like this video to be available to you and your students.

Privacy Settings

- Private Media page will be visible to the content owner only.
- Unlisted Media page will be visible to anyone with a link to the page.
- Published Media page will be visible to individuals according to entitlements on published destinations

Choose the privacy level you'd like for this video.

Note for online instructors: The "Unlisted" setting is sufficient for most of your needs. Using links and embed codes all students will have access to this video.

Save & Go To Media




- 1. Click **Save** to save the settings and information you've entered.
- 2. Click **Go To Media** to visit the video page. There you can find all the sharing options to share your video with your students.

How Do I Change the Privacy Settings on a Video That was Published Previously?


Privacy settings can be changed anytime during the lifespan of a video.

- 1. Click on your username in the upper right hand corner.
- 2. Select My Media from the drop down.

Select the Video



Click on the video thumbnail or the video title.

Publish



- 1. Below the video player click Actions.
- 2. Select **Publish** from the drop down menu.



How do I Install the Kaltura CaptureSpace Desktop Recorder?

The Kaltura CaptureSpace Desktop Recorder is a desktop application that will allow you to record presentations, lectures, screencasts, and more. Once you have recorded your media, CaptureSpace will allow you to trim and upload your media directly to Kaltura (video.byui.edu).

Navigate to Install Page




- 1. Click Add New
- 2. Select **Record a Presentation** from the drop-down menu.

Windows or Mac?



Choose the software download that is compatible with your computer's operating system.

Running CaptureSpace



Once the software is installed, repeating steps 1 & 2 will automatically open the CaptureSpace software. You may need to grant permission to allow the browser to launch the application.

How Do I Embed a Video from Kaltura into I-Learn?

Navigate to My Media




- 1. Click on your username (or button marked Guest if you're not logged in).
- 2. Click on My Media.

Select Video



Click on the video thumbnail image or the title of the video.

Choose Embed Settings




- 1. Click Share.
- 2. Click Embed.
- 3. Choose the player size. (*Note: 608x402 is wider than the Announcements widget on the course homepage, but does work.)
- 4. Copy the html embed code from the box.

Navigate to I-Learn Page


Select the announcement, discussion board, or content page in which you will embed the video.

Select Embed Location




Click that location to place your cursor at the point where you would like your video to appear.

Insert Stuff




With the content editor open, select the Insert Stuff button.

Paste Embed Code



Click Enter Embed Code.




- 1. Paste the embed code that you copied from Kaltura.
- 2. Click Next.

Preview & Insert




On this screen you can preview the size of your player and preview the video's contents. If you are ready to proceed you can click **Insert**. If you need to make any corrections to your embed code, you can click **Back**.

Finish Composing



Finish composing your item by adding any other text, images, etc.

Post / Publish



When you are ready, you can Publish your item.

*Note: HTML Source Editor



If you are more comfortable with editing HTML code directly, rather than using the WYSIWYG editor, you can do so by using the HTML Source Editor found in the bottom right hand corner of the content editor.
