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Elon Reeve Musk (/ˈiːlɒn ˈmʌsk/; born June 28, 1971) is a South African-born Canadian American business magnate, investor and inventor.[7][8][9][10][11][12] He is the CEO and CTO of SpaceX, CEO and product architect of Tesla Motors and chairman of SolarCity. He is the founder of SpaceX and a cofounder of Zip2, PayPal and Tesla Motors.[13][14][15] He has also envisioned a conceptual high-speed transportation system known as the Hyperloop and has proposed a VTOL supersonic jet aircraft with electric fan propulsion.[16][17]

Early childhood[edit]

Musk was born June 28, 1971, in Pretoria, Gauteng, South Africa,[18] to an upper-middle-class family;[19] the son of Maye (née Haldeman), a Canadian-born model,[20] and Errol Musk, a South African-born electromechanical engineer (with whom he has a troubled relationship).[20][21][22][23] His paternal grandmother was British, and he also has Pennsylvania Dutch ancestry.[24][25] After his parents divorced in 1980, Musk lived mostly with his father in locations in South Africa.[24]

At age 10, he discovered computing with the Commodore VIC-20.[26] He taught himself computer programming and at age 12 sold a BASIC listing for a video game called Blaster to a magazine called PC and Office Technology for approximately US\$500.[27] A web version of the game is available online.[28]

Musk was severely bullied throughout his childhood, and was once hospitalised when a group of boys threw him down a flight of stairs, and then beat him until he blacked out.[29]

At the age of 19, Musk was accepted into Queen's University in Kingston, Ontario for undergraduate study, and in 1992, after spending two years at Queen's University, Musk transferred to the University of Pennsylvania (Penn) where, at the age of 24, he received a Bachelor of Science degree in Physics from Penn's College of Arts and Sciences, and a Bachelor of Arts degree in Economics from the Wharton

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He is the founder, CEO and CTO of [SpaceX](#); co-founder, CEO and product architect of [Tesla Motors](#); co-founder and chairman of [SolarCity](#), co-chairman of [OpenAI](#); co-founder of [Zip2](#); and co-founder of [PayPal](#).^{[18][19][20]} As of June 2016, he has an estimated net worth of US\$12.7 billion, making him the 83rd wealthiest person in the world.

Musk has stated that the goals of SolarCity, Tesla Motors, and SpaceX revolve around his vision to change the world and humanity.^[21] His goals include reducing global warming through [sustainable energy](#) production and consumption, and reducing the "risk of human extinction" by "making life multiplanetary"^{[22][23]} by setting up a human colony on Mars.

He has envisioned a high-speed transportation system known as the [Hyperloop](#), and has proposed a VTOL supersonic jet aircraft with electric fan propulsion, known as the [Musk electric jet](#).^{[24][25]}
