### Responsibility Categories

1. **Professional Development** – SCTA, MSTA, professional organizations, conferences, etc.
2. **Continuing Education** – Classes or Workshops
3. **Curriculum Enhancement** – Working on curriculum
4. **Student Contact** – tutoring; clubs; summer health component
5. **Utilize instructional strategies to meet individual student needs** – creating and/or making activities to meet the needs of students
6. **Enhancement & Beautification of Buildings and Grounds** – picking up litter, working on landscaping, etc. This has to have prior approval from building principal.
7. **Master's Degree** – Can be used once during lifetime of career ladder eligibility for 15 hours
8. **National Certification** – such as National Board Certification for Teachers
