**Procedures and Protocols  
Masks after 03/31/2021**

Pursuant to the expiration of the mask mandate by the Governor of Arkansas, the Board Resolution passed by the Board on August 10, 2020 is no longer in effect. As a result, the following procedures and protocols have been put in place:

1. Staff (certified and classified) will no longer be required to wear a face covering.
2. Students will no longer be required to wear a face covering.
3. All visitors to school campuses will no longer be required to wear a face covering.
4. Teachers, students, and staff may be required to submit to a temperature check.
5. Limited entry of visitors (including parents) at both the elementary and high school will continue. Visitors may be asked to submit to a health screening including a temperature check and a series of questions to determine if they might have symptoms of COVID-19.
6. Teachers, students, and staff who desire to continue wearing a face covering may do so without any restrictions.
7. Teachers and staff may not require others (including parents and students) to wear a mask in their classrooms or office spaces.
8. Masks will still be made available when requested.
9. Hand sanitizer stations will still be available and maintained.
10. Water fountains will still be disabled.
11. Social distancing protocols will still be observed based on the recommendations of the Arkansas Department of Health.
