

**Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation  
Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)  
MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The <PWS NAME> water system PWS ID <PWS ID Number> has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

## Mandatory Language for Public Notice

### Triggered Source Monitoring and Reporting Violation: Ground Water Rule

Midway ISD 0390020 failed to collect the required number of triggered source bacteriological samples for fecal indicator monitoring of the ground water system during July 2016. This monitoring is required by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's "Drinking Water Standards" and the federal "Safe Drinking Water Act," Public Law 95-523.

Triggered source samples are used to monitor water quality and indicate if the water is free of fecal indicator bacteria. Following a positive routine total coliform result in our distribution system, our water system is required to submit one triggered source sample for every active ground water well. Failure to collect all required triggered source samples is a violation of the monitoring requirements and we are required to notify you of this violation.
