Summer 2021 Drivers Education

Students must be 14 years of age prior to the start of class.

In district cost is \$ 102.00, Out of District cost is \$300. Payment will need to be made to the high school office by May 7th 2021. Checks can be made out to BHS.

A Mandatory Student/Parents Zoom Meeting will be held April 28th at 6pm.

First day of Class will be May 24th at 9:00am

Note: A full calendar will be issued to the students once class has started and the number of students is known.

It is recommended that students obtain an instructional permit before Drivers Education starts, but it is not required.

A mastery of 80% must be achieved on all Drivers Education Test.

Classroom Policies and procedures:

NO Cell phones in class or when driving. Cell phones will be placed in a box before class. They may be picked up during breaks and after class. Same while driving. Students will have one warning, after that they will be asked to leave.

Come prepared for class, bring paper, pencils, books, homework, projects ready for the next day.

Students will have 3 chances to pass each test, after the 3rd try, if student doesn't pass, they will be dismissed from class. This is the KSDE state law.

Do not wear sandals while driving. Students must wear tennis shoes.

Please take time to take your student out and drive with them, the more experience the better the driving.

Please be on time! Only 1 unexcused absence will be permitted. After that the student will be excused from the class.

Please note: we can work around driving times, but students will need to be at all classroom times. Tests can only be taken in class. Most of the book work, lectures, and studying will be on-line. The student will need to stay on top of of this work and not fall behind. We will be using Teams again to minimize the time in class.
