

Proposed Hybrid Learning Model
For USD 244

- We are proposing an every other day attendance model with students being divided by administrators by alphabet, grade level, common family members, etc. Staff may be involved with input on student groupings.
- We would have a Red/Gray schedule where $\frac{1}{2}$ of the kids would be On-Site and $\frac{1}{2}$ of the kids would be Remote. For example: If it is a Red Week, the red group of kids will be On-Site Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Red students would be Remote on Tuesday and Thursday. Gray students would be On-Site on Tuesday and Thursday and Remote on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. If it is a Gray Week, the gray group of kids would be On-Site Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Gray students would be Remote on Tuesday and Thursday. Red students would be On-Site Tuesday and Thursday and Remote on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- One of the main reasons behind the every other day model is the social/emotional well-being of our kids.
- This model would be used if:
 - Our Coffey County Health Department or the State of Kansas tells us that we need to go to this model.
 - USD 244 deems the situation necessary to use the Hybrid Model.
- The Hybrid Model may be used by individual schools or specific grade levels if necessary.
- We would have PK classes every day due to small class sizes and $\frac{1}{2}$ day sessions.
- Other grade level decisions would be evaluated on a case by case situation by USD 244 administration and the Coffey County Health Department.
- Adjustments to this plan may occur as it is subject to change.
