Welcome - Jennifer Biddle, Chairperson

- 1) Sonya Corbell provided an update on the School Based Health Center grant. Corbell said the district did not receive the grant, but if you want to continue pursuing then express your support to Mr. Ward. The district is also working on a mileage increase that could assist with the cost of some of the expenses of the clinic.
- 2) Susan Gosdin provided Wellness Updates. She discussed wellness objectives, history, and rules and regulations. She discussed wellness policy and the required content, goals, guidelines, public involvement, public updates, policy leadership, and evaluation.
