Call the Meeting to order – Bil Kahanek called the meeting to order at 7:06 PM. The purpose of the meeting is to: approve the TEA 2017 Accountability Summary, the budget for 2017-18 fiscal year, approve Budget Amendments for 2016-17 Fiscal Year, and set the 2017-18 Tax Rate.

#### 2017-18 Fiscal Year Tax Rate

Willard Rother moved to set the Tax Rate for 2017-18 fiscal year as follows:

- Maintenance & Operations rate is \$1.04/\$100 taxable property valuation, the same rate as last year.
- Debt Service rate is \$0.06467/\$100 taxable property valuation, an increase of \$0.00467.

• Total Combined Tax Rate \$1.10467/\$100 Taxable Property Valuation. Win Harbison seconded the motion and it passed 7-0.
