1. Old Business -

- a. CATCH materials have been found. Only 6-8 grade materials were found. We have researched the need for the CATCH program and as long as we are following the Health TEKS (State Standards) we are in compliance with health instruction at every grade level.
- b. The recycling program is in full swing. Cans and plastic bottles are being collected in 3 large containers throughout the campus. We have also added a large metal recycling collection bin that is being used by the school. The large collection bin is also available to the public.
