INFORMATION AND OVERVIEW

Salado Youth Leadership (SYL) is designed for students in $9^{th} - 12^{th}$ grade who want to learn to be effective leaders. If you think you have leadership potential, or you have a desire to learn more about leadership and opportunities in your community, then Salado Youth Leadership is for you.

The purpose of Salado Youth Leadership is to train students in leadership techniques and community awareness so that they may become familiar with current issues, community resources, opportunities, and other factors influencing the direction of Salado's future. The program will require your time and participation. You will be expected to attend monthly sessions.

ELIGIBILITY/CRITERIA

Students who will be enrolled in the 9th – 12th grade at Salado High School during the 2019 – 2020 school year are eligible to apply. *Participants will be selected based upon the information provided in their application.*

All applicants must:

- Be in good academic standing.
- Be enrolled in the 9th 12th for the 2019 2020 school year.
- Be responsible for the \$125 tuition payment if selected. Need-based scholarships are available.
- Receive permission to participate from parent/guardian and principal or counselor.

SELECTION PROCESS

In order to be considered for selection, students must follow these application guidelines:

- Complete the entire application form.
- Get all necessary signatures on the applications (see Section 2 of the application).
- Provide a resume (see example at the end of this application).
- Ensure that the application is turned in **no later than 12:00 PM on June 4, 2019**.

Applications and payment can be dropped off at the high school main office, at the Civic Center, or mailed to Salado ISD, Salado Youth Leadership, P.O. Box 98, Salado, TX 76571.

NOTE: Only complete applications received by the deadline will be considered.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Financial assistance is available in the form of a grant for tuition for those students who currently receive free or reduced price lunch through SISD. A letter from the applicant's legal guardian stating why the scholarship is needed must be included with the application for consideration. Awards are based on need and will be granted in the order of request.

Students will be notified of acceptance in the program by June 27, 2019.

INSTRUCTIONS

Each application will be responsible for ensuring that the application is completed and postmarked prior to the deadline. <u>ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.</u>

- Section 1 is completed by the applicant.
- Section 2 is signed by (a) the applicant, (b) a parent or legal guardian, and (c) an educator.
- Sections 1 and 2 are sent by the applicant to Salado Youth Leadership at the address below.

Applications must be turned in no later than June 4, 2019. No exceptions.

Students will be notified of acceptance in the program June 27, 2019.
