ARTICLE I NAME OF COMMITTEE

The name of this committee shall be the Johnson O'Malley Parent Advisory Committee (JOM PAC)

ARTICLE II PURPOSE OF COMMITTEE

The establishment and the work of the parent committee are to comply with the rules and regulations as found in the Federal Register, 25CFR Ch.1 (4-1-95 edition) (part 273.16 powers and duties of an Indian Education Committee to complete the purposes.)

- Section 1. To promote the welfare of Indian children and youth in home, school, community and tribe.
- Section 2. To raise the standards of school achievement of Indian children.
- Section 3. To support positive relationships between the home and school/s that parents and teachers may cooperate collaboratively in the education of Indian children and youth.
- Section 4. The goal of this committee is to meet the academic needs of Indian students through special projects and programs and to involve Indian families in their child's education.

ARTICLE III MEMBERSHIP

- Section 1. Establishment of the Johnson O'Malley Parent Advisory Committee
 - A) According to Subpart A Sec. 273.15 of the April 1, 1995 regulations, an Indian Education Committee is to be elected from among the parents (including persons acting "in loco parentis") except school officials of eligible Indian students enrolled in the schools affected by a sub-contract under this part.
 - B) The JOM PAC shall be composed of five (5) members.
 - C) Those eligible to serve on the committee must be parents, guardian, or person acting in loco parentis of Indian Children enrolled in Kansas Public Schools, except that school board members, school employees or their spouses, those person who have a prior felony conviction, and registered sex offender are not eligible to serve.
