Community and Student Engagement Rating Formula (CaSE)

Texas Education Code, requires school districts to evaluate the condition of community and student engagement for the district and each campus, along with assigning a rating of Exemplary, Recognized, Acceptable, or Unacceptable. Campus and Districts submit performance ratings in 9 areas:

- (1) Fine Arts, (2) Wellness and Physical Education, (3) Community and Parent Involvement, (4) 21st Century Workforce, (5) Second Language Acquisition, (6) Digital Learning Environment, (7) Dropout Prevention, (8) Educational Programs for Gifted and Talented, and (9) Compliance with Statutory Reporting and Policy Requirements*.

PERFORMANCE INDICATORS	RATINGS CRITERIA
Performance Indicators have been set to describe how districts and campuses engage the community and students within a specific area.	Ratings Criteria have been set to determine levels of Exemplary, Recognized, Acceptable, and Unacceptable performance.

How are ratings determined in each of the 9 areas and overall for the district and campuses?

Ratings are assigned based on the number **INDICATORS ACHIEVED** in 8 of the reporting areas.

5 Points for Exemplary	4 Points for Recognized	3 Points for Acceptable	0-2 Points for Unacceptable
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****Compliance with Statutory Reporting receives a YES/NO rating. To receive a YES rating, a campus and district must attain 4 out of 5 indicators.***

Overall campus ratings are determined by the **TOTAL** number of points from each of the 8 areas, plus **YES** or **NO** on Compliance.

Overall district rating is determined by the **AVERAGE** number of points from **ALL** campuses, per reporting area, plus **YES** or **NO** on Compliance.
