

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF ATLANTA ISD, ATLANTA, TEXAS CALLING A JOINT GENERAL SCHOOL AND CITY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF ATLANTA ON SATURDAY, MAY 4, 2019; DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE JOINT ELECTION; AND FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION IS PASSED IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF ATLANTA ISD, ATLANTA, TEXAS:

Section 1: It is hereby ordered that a General City and AISD Joint Election will be held in and throughout the City of Atlanta, Texas, on Saturday, May 4, 2019, at which there shall be submitted to the duly qualified resident electors of the said City as to the election of a Council Member for District Two (2), District Three (3), District Four (4), and the AISD School Board Trustee's in the City of Atlanta, TX.

Section 2: That the present boundaries of the City of Atlanta and Atlanta Independent School District will constitute five voting precincts, the polls shall be open for voting from seven o'clock (7:00) a.m. until seven o'clock (7:00) p.m. at the following polling places, and the Election Administrator will appoint officers to conduct the election at said polling place:

SCHOOL DISTRICT PRECINCTS

Precincts (8-9-11) Bowie Cass Morris Building . 117 North St, Douglassville, TX

Precincts (19-21) Huffines Community Center - 6487 FM 251 S. Huffines, TX

Precinct (18) Smyrna Baptist Church-4621 TX Hwy 77 E, Smyrna, TX

Precincts (20E-2) Bivins Community Ctr. - 143 Morse Rd, Bivins, TX

The Polling place for all City Precincts and all other School Precincts is

ATLANTA CITY HALL, 315 BUCKNER ST., ATLANTA, TX 75551

The Elections Administrator will provide a copy of this resolution to the Election Judge and the Alternate Judge as written notice of their appointment as required by Section 32.009 of the Texas Election Code.

The Presiding Judge shall have the authority to appoint no more than six (6) clerks

to assist in the holding of such election, but in no event shall the presiding Judge appoint less than two clerks. Said election officers shall also serve as the Early Voting Ballot Board for such election: the Presiding Judge of such election precinct shall also serve as the Presiding Officer of the Early Voting Ballot Board.

The Election Judge shall be compensated at an hourly rate of \$10; early voting clerk and election clerks shall be compensated at an hourly rate of \$8 as provided by Title 3, Section 32.091 (a) of the State Election Code. The Election Judge shall be compensated in the amount of \$30 for the delivery of election equipment and supplies as provided by Title 3, Section 32.091 (a) of the State Election Code, if such delivery is necessary.

Section 3: That Danica Porter, Atlanta City Secretary, be designated as Early Voting Clerk for the Joint General Election between the City of Atlanta and Atlanta Independent School District; the appointment of a deputy clerk or clerks for early voting shall be in accordance with Section 83.001 et seq. of the Texas Election Code.

The place for early voting shall be held by the City Secretary at the City Hall Office and process all applications for absentee voting by mail. The place for early voting for such election is hereby designated as:

Atlanta City Hall, 315 Buckner St., Atlanta, TX 75551


The early voting clerk, in accordance with the provision of the Texas Election Code, shall maintain a roster listing on each person who votes early by personal appearance and each person to whom a ballot to be voted by mail is sent. The roster shall be maintained in a form approved by the Secretary of State.

Section 4: All ballots shall be prepared in accordance with Texas Election Code. Paper ballots shall be used for early voting by mail and eSlate Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) Voting System shall be used for early voting by personal appearance and voting on Election Day, both of which are part of the eSlate DRE Voting System. The City Council hereby adopts for use in early and election day voting the eSlate Direct Recording Electronic (DRE) Voting System as approved by the Secretary of State. All expenditures necessary for the conduct of the election, the purchase of materials therefore, and the employment of all election officials is hereby authorized.


Section 5: Notice of this election shall be given in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and returns of such notice shall be made as provided for in said Code. The Mayor shall issue all necessary orders and writs for such election, and returns of such election shall be made to the City Secretary after the closing of the polls.

Section 6: Said election shall be held in accordance with Texas Election Code and the Federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.
