

Safe and Healthy Return to School Update

Atlanta ISD looks forward to having students on campuses. Many interventions have been employed to create a safe and healthy atmosphere for our students, faculty, and staff. Below are brief highlights of our protocols for return to school.

Atlanta ISD Safety and Health Protocols for 2020-2021

- In accordance with the Governor's rule, faculty and students in grades four and over will wear masks (this includes non-medical grade disposable masks, cloth face coverings, or shields).
- Masks will be provided to the extent possible.
- Visitors will be minimal and will be subject to the approval of campus administrators.
- Parents will be expected to screen students daily for symptoms of COVID-19 and keep them home if they exhibit them. Parents are advised to seek medical evaluation at that point. Screening forms will be provided.
- Faculty and staff will self-screen daily and will not report to campus if they exhibit COVID-19 symptoms.
- Students who have been in close contact with an individual who tests positive for COVID-19 must quarantine for 14 days and will be provided at-home remote learning.
- Please see CDC guidelines www.cdc.gov for COVID-19 symptoms, details regarding return to work/school criteria and definition of close contact (also listed in our full-length plan).
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfection of surfaces will be implemented. This includes buses, classrooms, restrooms, offices, cafeterias, and other common areas.
- Students will have hand-sanitizer available upon entrance to the building and their classrooms.
- Efforts will be made to socially distance where feasible in classrooms, hallways, and the cafeteria.
- Students and faculty will be trained on strategies to reduce the risk of transmission upon return to campus.
