

NOTICE OF SCHOOL BOARD VACANCY

The Strother Public School District is seeking applications for the current vacant position on the Board of Education created by the resignation of Terry Ter Wee, who held seat 4.

To be eligible to be a member of the Strother Board of Education, a person must have resided in the district for at least six months and have been a registered voter registered with the county election board at an address located within the geographical boundaries of the district for six months. Interested persons should submit a letter of interest with a brief description of their qualifications for the position and the reason for their interest in the position to the Superintendent's office, Strother Public School 36085 EW 1140 Seminole, OK 74868. no later than 3:00 p.m. on **Wednesday, June 20, 2018.**

Following a review of submitted materials, and possible interviews with some candidates, (it is possible that not all applicants for the vacancy will be interviewed), one individual will be appointed to fill the vacant position. **The selected individual will be required to run for election at the next regularly scheduled election in 2019.** The filing period for that election is in December of 2018.
