

Mountain Pine School District: Accepting Bids for HVAC and Ionization Upgrade

The Mountain Pine School District in Mountain Pine, Arkansas is accepting sealed bids beginning May 19, 2021 for installation of an HVAC upgrade for elementary and high school classrooms and field house. The District would prefer addition of Needle Point Bipolar Ionization in existing HVAC equipment, with monitoring and software provided to measure air quality.

Bids should include eliminating side wall supply grills and adding supply openings in 10 elementary classrooms and 10 high school classrooms to improve air distribution, as well as two heat and cool gas package units for the field house (with all materials and labor).

Vendors must be registered with the System for Award Management (sam.gov), which is an official website of the U.S. government. Vendors must follow the Davis-Bacon and Related Acts, applying to contractors and subcontractors performing on federally funded or assisted contracts in excess of \$2,000 for the construction, alteration, or repair of public buildings. Laborers and mechanics (including those working on duct, pipe, and mechanical system installation) must be paid no less than the locally prevailing wages and fringe benefits for corresponding work on similar projects in the area. For contracts in excess of \$100,000, contractors and subcontractors must pay workers at least one and one-half times their regular rate of pay for all hours worked over 40 in a workweek. Sealed bids will be accepted from May 19, 2021 until June 1, 2021. The District encourages submissions from small and minority owned businesses, women's business enterprises and labor surplus area firms.
