Annual Parent Orientation

Annually, La Joya ISD holds a District Gifted and Talented meeting, as well as campus, and cluster meetings for parents / guardians and other community members to receive information of the Gifted and Talented Program.

GT teachers and / or GT Designees from each campus provide parents with information on the G/T identification process and the service design for students. Parents are given the opportunity to refer their children for the program. Orientation sessions are held for parents on the awareness of the Gifted and Talented Education Program in which other community members are invited. The community is kept aware of the programs through the Local school newspaper:” The “Noticiero”, flyers, brochures, programs, meetings and (channel 17).
