La Joya I.S.D. collaborates with the Texas Virtual School Network to offer virtual classes for 8th-12th grade students in all academic content areas as well as elective courses to help student meet their graduation requirements. All courses offered meet Texas Education requirements. Students may take up to two virtual classes per semester. Instruction and content are delivered primarily over the Internet. The student and certified instructor are in different locations. A student is not required to be on the physical premises of a school except when taking course exams.

The student is responsible for one-half of the course fee. The fee will vary from \$125-\$200 based on the course and time of enrollment. Students need to visit with their counselor to verify the course fee.

All registration steps must be completed.

Student Eligibility

Please review the following information before enrolling students in TxVSN courses. Students must meet these criteria:

- A student must be younger than 21 years of age and has not graduated from high school. A student who is younger than 26 years of age and entitled to the benefits of the Foundation School Program, **Section 42.003**.
- Students currently in grades 8-12 are eligible to enroll in TxVSN courses.
- A student must be enrolled in a Texas School District or Open-Enrollment Charter School serving grades 8-12.
- Students enrolled in a TXVSN course are required to complete state assessments aligned to the course they are enrolled.
- Students enrolled in Dual Credit courses must meet The Higher Education Coordinating Board's (THECB) enrollment priorities.
- **Additional Considerations:**
- Students must have regular access to an Internet-connected multimedia computer at home or on campus. The course instructor will designate a time to connect to the online course(s).
- Students should have readiness skills to be a successful online learner. TxVSN courses are rigorous.
- Each college or university that offers dual credit courses through TxVSN will have an additional registration process to complete for each student. Please refer to the information page of the college or university offering the course for more information.
- Students may take a TxVSN course as part of normal course load as well as an outside normal course load.
